Georgia Law enrolls its highest credentialed class ever

The most academically talented class in the history of the law school recently began the three-year pursuit of a law degree. The Class of 2012 is comprised of 241 students from 27 states and 90 undergraduate schools. More than half of the students starting this fall scored 164 or higher on the Law School Admission Test, placing these students in the top 10 percent of test takers nationwide. The median undergraduate grade point average of the class is 3.7. (learn more)
