GRADE DISTRIBUTION FOR FALL SEMESTER 2000

The majority of University of Georgia School of Law students are not academically ranked. Only those members of a class whose cumulative grade point averages are in the top ten percent or who have a cumulative grade point average greater than 3.5 are ranked.

The following grade point distributions are provided to assist students and prospective employers in determining the general range of a particular student's grade point average. This chart represents the distribution of cumulative grade point averages at the end of Fall Semester 2000. Members of the Class of 2003 and transfer students to the Class of 2002 will be included in the grade distribution compiled following the 2000-2001 Academic Year.
