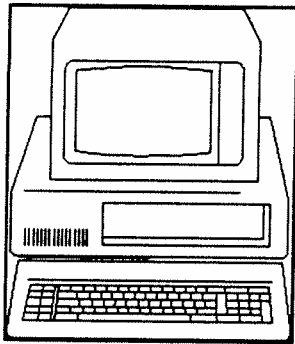

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WESTLAW AND LEXIS STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES

Both Westlaw and Lexis have hired student representatives to be available in Room A211 of the Library Annex to help students with computer searches.

Westlaw has hired Michael Cavalier, a third-year student. Michael is from Louisiana and has an undergraduate degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Southwestern Louisiana. He was a member of the 1989-90 Editorial Board of the Georgia Journal of International and Comparative Law. Last summer, Michael clerked for Akin, Gump, Strauss, Hauer & Feld in Dallas, Texas. He plans to return to that firm upon graduation.

Michael will be available to answer questions at the following times: Monday (9:30am - 11:30am and 3:30pm - 7:30pm), Tuesday (8:00am - 9:30am, 1:30pm - 5:00pm and 6:30pm - 8:30 pm), Wednesday (9:30am - 11:30am and 3:30pm - 7:00pm), Thursday (8:00am - 9:30am and 1:30pm - 5:00pm), Friday (8:00am - 9:30am).

Lexis has hired two representatives - third-year law student Liz Ortega and second-year law student Chris Sabec. Liz is a former Lexis student trainer and a member of the Managing Board of the Georgia Law Review. Liz has a Masters in Accounting from the University of Georgia. She is planning to clerk for Judge Tidwell of the Eleventh Circuit upon graduation.

Chris Sabec is a graduate of Georgetown University. He is a member of the current Editorial Board of the Georgia Journal of International and Comparative Law. Last summer Chris interned at the White House in Washington, D.C.

The Library staff is here to assist users in providing access to legal information. The following services are designed to make library research easier:

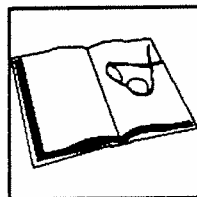
REFERENCE

Feel free to stop by the Circulation Office or the Annex Library Office to ask for help in locating or using library materials. Library staff members work weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.; Saturdays, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; and Sundays, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. At other times the Circulation Desk is staffed by law students who can often help in locating materials. If no one is available to answer your questions, leave a note at the Circulation Desk stating the question along with your name and message box number on it. As soon as possible, someone will get in touch with you.



INTERLIBRARY LOAN

Materials that are not available in the Law Library or the Main/Science Libraries of the University of Georgia may be requested through interlibrary loan. A request sheet may be obtained in the Circulation Office. Materials requested usually take ten days to two weeks to



arrive and, in some cases, a fee is charged for the materials.

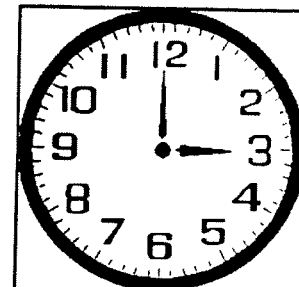
MORE WESTLAW AND LEXIS NEWS

Many of you may have already noticed that passwords are no longer displayed on the Westlaw and Lexis computers. Consequently, students must use their individual ids. To obtain a Lexis id, you must see Lexis student representative Chris Sabec or Liz Ortega. Westlaw contracts and passwords were placed in all second and third year students' mailboxes. Westlaw contracts must be filled out, signed and returned to the Library Circulation desk. If you have misplaced your Westlaw contract please contact Westlaw student representative Michael Cavalier or the Law Library staff.

Students wishing to access Lexis from home may check out Lexis software for three days from the Circulation desk. A manual including a toll-free customer service telephone number is available. Students wishing to access Westlaw from home should fill out the reverse side of their Westlaw contract. Westlaw will then mail each student a software package including a manual and toll-free customer service telephone number.

LIBRARY FINES

MORE WESTLAW AND LEXIS NEWS

Both Westlaw and Lexis
have added new databases which
might be of interest to law
students.

Westlaw has added the
National Association for Law
Placement Directory. To
access NALP, type **db nalp-dir**.
In the NALP database you can
retrieve such basic
information as an employer's
size, location, and areas of
practice. You can also find
such information as the number
of minority attorneys,
partnership track data,
billable hour requirements and
hiring criteria.

Lexis has added a new
International Law Library.
Among the many materials in
this library are
International Legal Materials,
American Journal of
International Law, United
Nations Chronicle, European
Community materials, basic
documents of international
economic law, Commonwealth law
and French law.

WORDPERFECT 5.1
