#### E-MAIL FOR LAW STUDENTS!!

A world of resources is now at your fingertips! All interested law students can sign up for electronic mail accounts on the UGA Mainframe. The form for signing up for an account is on the reverse side of this newsletter. Please fill out this



form and return to the Law Library Circulation Desk as soon as possible. Students may access e-mail accounts using the computers in the word-processing or from home via modem. The Law Library staff with offer classes on using e-mail. See the announcement below for details.

The e-mail account, otherwise known as a CONTAC account, will allow students to access a variety of computing resources:

Students can communicate with other students who have e-mail accounts, both within the Law School and at other institutions around the world. Students can access a wide variety of internet resources.

The online catalogs of many libraries such as the Library of Congress, Columbia Law Library, Harvard Law Library, and other libraries within the state of Georgia are available.

Students can join discussion groups. These discussion groups may be related to legal issues such as environmental law or family law. Students can also join groups which discuss recreational topics such as popular novels, music, etc.

Sign up for a CONTAC account. Attend the classes offered by the library staff and find out what Internet is all about!
