The Circulation Staff would like to remind law students of the following policies:



Copicards are only sold in the Circulation Office between the hours of 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Monday - Friday. Do not use copicards purchased from the Law Library in the UGA Main Library photocopiers and do not use copicards purchased

from the UGA Main Library in the Law Library photocopiers. For your own safety, please do not attempt to repair Law Library photocopy machines. If a photocopier needs paper, toner, toner disposal, etc., please alert the Law Library staff. Remember, toner is a hazardous material



Students may obtain stacking permits to store individual collections of Library materials on tables in the Law Library. These permits may be obtained by students working on: (1) Georgia Law Review, Georgia Journal of International and

Comparative Law, or Georgia Journal of Intellectual Property Law project, (2) Moot Court Team brief, (3) Writing Requirement, or (4) an individual project specifically authorized by the Public Services Librarians. A stacking permit is valid for 3 weeks and may be renewed for 3 more weeks. Students are not permitted to have a stacking permit for longer than 6 weeks per semester. The stacking permit should be displayed with the library stack. The stacking permit contains a list of rules. Please read these rules carefully.

Free Westlaw and Lexis software is available to second and third year students for home access. Software is available for either DOS or WINDOWS in 3.5" or 5.25" format. Software is also available for either MacIntosh or IBM compatibles. Software is stored on the bookcases in the Westlaw/Lexis lab. Feel free to pick up your software at any time in the lab. Lexis is planning to release an software upgrade for home access very soon. When the upgrade arrives, we'll post announcements around the Law School.
