## University of Georgia School of Law Spring 2018 Grade Distribution

The majority of University of Georgia School of Law students are not ranked in numerical order. Only those members of a class whose cumulative grade point averages are in the top twenty-five percent are ranked in numerical order.

The following information is provided to assist students and prospective employers in determining the general range of a particular student's grade point average. This chart represents the distribution of cumulative grade point averages at the end of the Spring 2018 Semester.
