Law School Association

The University of Georgia Law School Association Council, the governing body of the Association, held its regular annual meeting on Saturday, November 4, 1972, at the School of Law. Members present included President Kenneth M. Henson, Dean Ralph Beard, Judges William B. Gunter and Newell Edenfield, Hamilton Lokey, Kirk McAlpin, Frank Seiler, Robert H. Smalley, Jr., and J. W. Walters.

University of Georgia Law School Alumni breakfasts were held at the mid-year meeting of the State Bar in Macon December 8, and at the annual meeting of the State Bar in Savannah June 8. President Henson conducted both meetings. Dean Beard addressed the alumni on the state of the Law School at each meeting. Approximately 45 persons attended the Macon meeting, and 90 were present at the Savannah breakfast.

It was decided by vote at the Savannah meeting that a "Talmadge" chair will be established at the Law School. A capital amount of \$350,000 must be raised for this professorship.

Justice William B. Gunter was elected president-elect of the Law School Association. Kirk McAlpin assumed his duties as 1973-74 president of the Association.
