INTERNATIONAL ADJUDICATION: PROCEDURAL ASPECTS. By V.S. Mani. The Hague, The Netherlands: Martinus Nijhoff Publishers BV, 1980. Pp. 445. Dfl. 130.00. This is the fourth volume of the series *Developments in International Law*, and deals exclusively with procedure in the international context.

THE INTERNATIONAL LAW AND POLICY OF HUMAN WELFARE. Edited by Ronald St. John MacDonald, Q.C., Douglas M. Johnston, and Gerald Morris. Alphen aan den Rijn, The Netherlands: Sijthoff & Noordhoff International, 1978. Pp. 690. Composed of twenty-five essays, part I of this admirable work deals with the concepts underlying the international legal order as they affect human development. Part II presents essays centering upon human rights. Part III stresses developments in the new legal and economic international order. Part IV concludes with problems encountered in the promotion of physical welfare, particularly as presented at recent international conferences sponsored by the United Nations.

LOCAL POLITICS IN COMMUNIST COUNTRIES. Edited by Daniel N. Nelson. Lexington, Kentucky: The University Press of Kentucky, 1980. Pp. 230. \$17.50. Eight scholars examine issues of political participation at lower governmental levels in the Soviet Union, Yugoslavia, The People's Republic of China, Poland, and Romania.

PRISONERS OF WAR IN INTERNATIONAL ARMED CONFLICT. By Howard Levie, Newport, Rhode Island: Naval War College Press. Pp. 529. This book discusses the Geneva Prisoner of War Conven-

tion. Its format, which traces a POW from the moment of capture to release, makes for interesting reading.

SCHMITTHOFF'S EXPORT TRADE, THE LAW AND PRACTICE OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE. By Clive Schmitthoff. London, England: Stevens and Sons, 1980. Pp. 515. This work discusses patents, trademarks, financing, insurance and customs law.
